Policy for SRAL News

The Santa Rita Art League (SRAL) of GVR is a vital art organization for members of GVR. SRAL keeps its members informed with art league news through Eblasts, a website, and emails sent by Special Interest Group's (SIG's) chairpersons. The website also promotes SRAL activities for prospective members and Green Valley and surrounding area residents who are interested in art.

SRAL's publicity chairperson sends monthly general meeting and exhibit reception announcements to GVR's publication people to be included in their printed material each month. The chairperson also sends this information to GV News to be included in "What's Happening."

Eblasts are published twice a month by the Eblast editor from October through May and once a month from June through September. It contains the following news:

- Message from the president or co-presidents
- Monthly General Meeting Demonstration Descriptions
- Exhibit Information announcement, link to prospectus, announcement of winners and photos of their artwork
- Management Information such as membership renewal, monitor training, and locker/slot rentals.
